These temporary appointments are not reflected in the counts above.

Comments: Personnel figures are as of July 1, 2003. Sacramental and household information is 2002 data. **The projected number of priests does not necessarily mean full time priest pastors. Since all pastoral leadership positions are open to pastoral administrators, a "projected priest" could be a sacramental minister who serves with a pastoral administrator on either a full time or part time basis.** These four parishes were led by four resident priest pastors until 1996.
