

a table of solid or suitable material for the celebration of the Eucharist



a place for proclaiming Scripture and preaching the Good News



cupboard; the container for the stock of holy oils



statues of the immortal creatures created by God to serve him and to act as messengers to carry out the plan of salvation



a basin serving as a receptacle for water where the sacrament of Baptism is celebrated

the place for song-leading and all non-scriptural speaking



the bishop's chair in a cathedral church



symbol of the Bishop's authority; a shepherd's staff or crook



a six-foot statue of the mother of God and Jesus



ceremonial headgear; folding two-piece stiffened hat of silk or linen,

when lit, this candle symbolizes Christ as the light of the world



a light indicating the presence of the reserved Sacrament



windows made up of colored glass forming pictures



The depiction of the final hours (or Passion) of Jesus



a safe-like, secure place of reservation for and worship of the Blessed Sacrament
