minutes; Junior high-adult; Oblate Media, 2010). This program provides a comprehensive overview of the special days and seasons of the Church year. Each season of the liturgical year is presented along with some of the feast days likely to occur during that time period. As our Church approaches a new liturgical year this program is well-suited as a refresher or an introduction for this topic.

As the Church enters liturgical Year A we will encounter once again the Gospel According to Matthew. A segment from the "Scripture From Scratch" series (60 minutes; Adults; St. Anthony Messenger Press, 1991) titled "Matthew: The Mature Jew" answers questions about who wrote this Gospel and what sources were used as well as when and why it was written. Fr. Michael Himes, the host of "The Gospel of Matthew" (28 minutes; Adults; Fisher Productions), sees it as "the Christian book of wisdom" inviting the reader to become a wise scribe of the new law. Matthew's Gospel reveals what it means to be church and viewers will learn that means being a community from which no one is excluded.
