1. Support for the emerging ministry of the 5 <sup>th</sup> priest assigned as sacramental minister for St. Bridget/St. Joseph, East Bloomfield and to develop and coordinate collaborative support for the hospital, jail, hospice and nursing home ministries of the planning group.	Fr. Doug DellaPietra assigned and collaborative support implemented including training of lay volunteers.
2. Lay leadership collaboration.	Brainstormed and summarized potential responses.
3. Volunteer recruitment and training collaboration.	Brainstormed and summarized potential responses.
4. Social ministry collaboration.	One parish prepared awareness of social ministry volunteer opportunities. Exploring collaboration for future videos and submitted planning group grant for improved equipment. Brainstormed and summarized potential responses.
5. Evangelization collaboration.	Brainstormed and summarized potential responses.
6. Life-long learning collaboration.	Planning to brainstorm and summarize potential responses.
7. Young adult ministry collaboration.	Brainstormed and summarized potential responses, including meeting with diocesan Young Adult Ministry Coordinator.
8. Youth ministry collaboration. Hire shared youth minister for region.	Decided this would be a priority initiative. Scheduling networking meeting of those involved in youth ministry. Will invite diocesan Youth Ministry Coordinator to future meeting.
