## Local Catholic Ministries Appeal at more than 90 percent of goal

With three months to go, \$4.8 million has been raised toward \$5.3 million goal

Roman Catholics in the 12-county Diocese of Rochester have donated more than \$4.8 million toward Bishop Matthew Clark's \$5.3 million Catholic Ministries Appeal goal for 2006-07. The Appeal is running about \$400,000 ahead of last year at this point in time. More than 37,000 gifts have been received.
