KEY POLICY STATEMENTS:

In accordance with Article 9 and Article 12 of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* promulgated by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) in 2002 and revised in 2018, the following Safe Environment programs are provided to children in the Diocese of Rochester:

- The Circles of Care curriculum for children is used in the Diocese of Rochester's Catholic Schools.
- The Creating a Safe Environment: Sexual Abuse Awareness Educational Resource Material for Parish Catechetical Programs is used for children in parish religious education programs.

APPLIES TO: All Diocese of Rochester Catholic Schools and all Diocese of Rochester parish religious education programs.

DETAILS:

- The *Circles of Care* curriculum for children is incorporated into the regular school curriculum, rooted in our Catholic faith.
- The Creating a Safe Environment: Sexual Abuse Awareness Educational Resource Material for Parish Catechetical Programs is used for children in parish religious education programs, offering a minimum of three (3) hours of Sexual Abuse Awareness education on an annual basis at each age/grade level.
